FRESH LOOK FOR BREWERY GULCH INN

Mendocino, CA- May, 2008 - There's a new look at Brewery Gulch Inn, 9401 North Highway One, with the completion of a renovation on all the rooms. The popular Craftsman-style inn overlooking Smuggler's Cove and the Pacific Ocean, opened in 2001. It is one mile south of the historic town of Mendocino.

“We spread the major room changes over a seven month period keeping suggestions in mind from guests, as well as our staff. With our important Green Hotel Certification in mind, we selected the Pasadena firm of Scott Brown Design to work with us in not only updating the property, but also in helping us in make ecologically friendly choices whenever possible,” says owner Guy Pacurar, who bought the inn last August. “For guests’ convenience, closets have been added to each room where previously armoires served for clothes storage. The Jacuzzi/soaking tubs in four of the rooms are now wrapped in travertine and glass. A much-needed ventilation system was put in our loft rooms, as well as a redesign of those two rooms so they can be used as a suite when desired for families or friends traveling together.”

All the rooms have new carpeting and have been repainted with eco-spec paint. Additionally, each has high quality organic towels, imported bed linens from Sferre, flat-panel televisions with DVD players, and iHome clock radios. Wi-fi service is now available throughout the inn and has been extended to the rear deck area off the first floor Great Room. A guest computer has been installed in the lobby that makes it easy to access e-mail and visit linked websites for local vineyards, restaurants, and other area attractions. Guest can enjoy a DVD collection with over 300 contemporary, classic, and foreign titles, as well as an assortment of games that many choose to enjoy playing in front of the Great Room's striking hand-forged steel and glass wood-burning fireplace.

The grounds, too, have undergone renovation with the installation of new landscaping at the entrance, an expansion of the vegetable/herb garden, and new furniture on the rear deck overlooking the Pacific.

What hasn't changed are the outstanding made-to-order breakfasts, innovative dishes served at the wine hour, concierge service, and a staff that is ready to make a visit to Brewery Gulch Inn a memorable travel experience.
